^{*} Polar waters means Arctic waters and/or the Antarctic area, as defined in Annex XVI Regulation 1 (4) of the SOLAS Convention.

^{*}Approved seagoing service equivalent to seagoing service in polar waters: Seagoing service is approved as equivalent to seagoing service in polar waters when it is performed during the period November 1 – April 30 in waters where ice is present in concentrations of at least 1/10 and the seagoing service is performed in the following sea areas: 1) the Gulf of Bothnia including the Sea of Åland and the Archipelago Sea north of the Hanko parallel of latitude; 2) the Bay of Bothnia north of the Vaasa-Umeå line; 3) the Gulf of Finland east of the Hanko meridian; and 4) in the St. Lawrence river and estuary as far as the Belle Isle meridian north of Newfoundland, and as far as the Channel-Port aux Basques meridian south of Newfoundland.
